## CONSEQUENCES:

We are not here to judge but to encourage and to guide. Sometimes the journey of helping to build players into the people God wants them to be, there must be love but also accountability.

These consequences are in place in order to help players grow and be shaped more into who they are meant to be. We are hoping that in knowing the guidelines and consequences, players will be more aware of how their actions might be perceived and reflect on themselves, IGNITE and God. However, if someone chooses to violate any of the guidelines above the following actions will be taken:

***First incident: 2 practice suspension and 1 match removal from the line-up.***

***Second Incident: 1 week practice suspension & removal from the line-up for the next tournament.***

***Third Incident: Removal from the team***
